

SOFTER WATER DURING RENOVATION OF WATER PLANT #1

Cypress Hill MUD #1 has two water production facilities. The wells associated with those facilities produce water with differing levels of hardness. One of these facilities, Water Plant #1, was taken out of service for renovation and expansion on March 1st . Currently all of the District's water is coming from Water Plant #2. The water coming from the well at that facility has a much lower 'hardness' level (that is, it is softer water), which you may have noticed.

Softer water is considered more desirable by most customers, as there is no scaling and spotting associated with it, as may be the case with harder water. In fact, many customers install water softeners to remove the hardness. There are no health concerns with soft water.

All customers on the system will experience the softer water until we get Water Plant #1 back in service, which should be sometime late this year if all goes according to plans.
